OVERVIEW

Lake Country single-sided wool cutting pads are traditional wool buffing pads sized for professional cutting or polishing stages. Manufacturer pad-care guidance emphasizes spurring and caution with water washing.

DIRECTIONS

- 1 Mount the pad on a compatible rotary or DA backing plate (or 5/8"-11 spindle for double-sided styles) centered and secure.
- 2 Apply compound to the pad or panel; start at a controlled speed and keep the pad moving — do not dwell in one spot.
- 3 For twisted/knitted wool, use a pad spur between passes to break up dried residue as recommended by Lake Country.
- 4 Clean per Lake Country pad-care instructions (System 4000® / Snappy Clean Boost™ or gentle wash); air dry — hot water can shrink loop/wool.

ROTARY WOOL — EYE PROTECTION; KEEP PAD MOVING

Non-chemical article. Follow Lake Country wool pad-care instructions.
